

The Special Called Meeting of the Northport City Council convened at 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 2, 2025 at Northport City Hall, located at 3500 McFarland Blvd, Northport, AL, 35476, in the Council Chambers to Canvas Election Results from August 26, 2025. The invocation was offered by Mayor Hinton and President Bobo led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon roll call, the following were found to be present: Pro Tem Washington, Councilman Aiken, Councilwoman Dykes and President Bobo. Also present at tonight’s meeting, Mayor Hinton and City Administrator Webb. Councilman Wiggins was absent.

Paperwork indicating twelve provisional ballots being cast in the Municipal Election on August 26, 2025 was turned in to the Board of Registrar’s Office on Wednesday, August 27, 2025. The Board of Registrar’s returned a report stating that six of the twelve ballots would be accepted. (District 1 – 1 ballot, District 2 – 3 ballots, District 3 – 1 ballot, District 4 – 0 ballots, District 5 – 1 ballot). In the presence of the council, staff and the public, Assistant City Clerk, Malorie Mixon opened the provisional boxes for Districts 1, 2, 3 and 5. Upon opening District 3’s box, there were no ballots present. After discussion with City Administrator, Glenda Webb and City Attorney, Ron Davis, and understanding that 1 ballot for District 3 or the Mayoral election would not override the majority winners in either election, five ballots were processed with the assistance of the Probate Judge’s office. The provisional ballot results were included with previous totals to create an official result.

**Motion** by Councilman Aiken, **Second** by Pro Tem Washington to approve the agenda for September 2, 2025 with an amendment to Item 9.b.1. to reflect provisional votes. **Roll call was as follows:** Pro Tem Washington, Yes; Councilman Wiggins, Absent; Councilwoman Dykes, Yes; Councilman Aiken, Yes; President Bobo, Yes. **Motion Carried.**

City Administrator, Glenda Webb presented the Official Election Results.

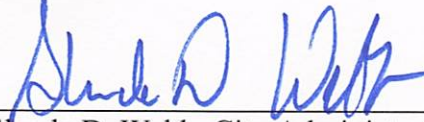

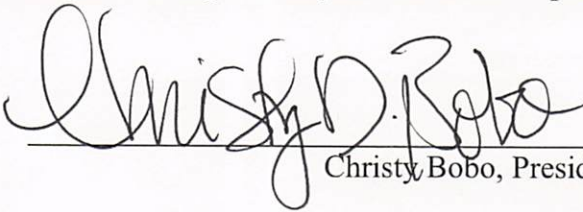
